YULETIDE TREE GIFT PROGRAM

The National Christmas Tree Association has been approached by Yuletide Gift Tree, Inc. about a program that will:

- Supply discount cards to Christmas Tree Growers for the Growers/retailers to give to their Customers this is at no charge to the grower or the association.
- The idea is to add value to the Real Trees (once a consumer buys the tree, he gets a coupon to help him put more presents under it)
- It also has potential to be a huge Cause Marketing campaign the program gives money to the Salvation Army and the Christmas SPIRIT Foundation. He proposes that Yuletide will:
 - Pay 2 ½ cents to the State/Regional Association for each card distributed by its members/ participants
 - 2. Donate 2 1/2 cents to the Salvation Army for each card distributed nationally
 - 3. Pay 1/2 cent per card distributed nationally to NCTA
 - 4. Donate 1/2 cent per card distributed nationally to the Christmas SPIRIT Foundation

Yuletide's plan is to contract individually with each state/regional association and work with that association to contact the members/participants from that state. This would be a State Association program, tied together the National association.

The cards are:

- Approximately 17 inches tall by 6 ½ inches wide. They will be made of a "plastic" weather-proof material.
- We would have input into the design of the front of the card for our state/regional association. It
 could have our logo on it, positive Real Tree messages, and the Salvation Army logo.
- The back of all cards would be identical same stores, etc. (Stores include Sears, Toys R Us, Foot Locker, Bed, Bath & Beyond, Hallmark, Radio Shack, Crate & Barrel, JC Penny, Blockbuster Video, TJ Max, Neiman Marcus, Best Buy 37 total) There is an early version of a mock up of the card at: http://www.christmastree.org/yuletide.cfm. (you may want to print this to show your board.)
- The cards offer Real Tree customers a discount on a one-time purchase at each of the stores represented. The card is perforated so when the customer wants to use a card for one store, he detaches that portion of the card, the store employee scans it and keeps that portion of the card.
- Offers will vary, but it is anticipated that most will offer a 10% discount on a one-time purchase (multiple items).

We can decide whether we want our portion of the program to be open to members-only or to any grower in the state. Members-only might increase membership... allowing non-members to participate might increase participation and our income (we still get the 2 ½ cents)

Our members/participants will need to sign up for the program and estimate the number of cards needed. They will also need to report the actual number of cards distributed at the end of the season.

Yuletide will ship the cards directly to the participants (growers). (No charge to growers or the Association)

If a grower signs up for the program and sells wholesale trees to other retailers, that grower will need to ship the cards along with each order. In this case, the retailer will NOT need to report the number distributed – that will be done by the participating member of the State Association.

There will be some extra cards printed, but in order to be sure each member gets what they need, they need to sign up during the "sign up window" (anticipated to be between "very soon" and July 17)

The goal is to distribute 40 million cards nationally.

Participants may order cards for, and distribute with the sale of wreaths made from Real Christmas Tree greenery.

Promotion will focus on Real Trees (not wreaths).

The number of cards available for distribution with wreaths may be limited if we get orders for cards near the 40 million mark.

The spirit of the program is to distribute one card per customer, so we should order based on the anticipated number of customers... (For example, if we know that we sell 400 wreaths to Real tree customers and 200 to people who buy only the wreath, then we should order cards for all tree sales plus 200 extra for wreath-only sales.)






